



**Fluid Resuscitation** (For Adults > 15% burn, Children > 10% burn)

**For 1<sup>st</sup> 8 hours:** 0.25 mls x % Burn x weight (kg) = mls / hour **Hartmann's solution**  
**For next 16 hours:** 0.125 mls x % Burn x weight (kg) = mls / hour **Hartmann's solution**

This is based on 4mls/kg/% burn, half over first eight hours, rest over next 16 hours. Fluid is calculated from **time of injury** not presentation so a “catch up” bolus may be required.  
Please check flowchart to see if oral intake is allowed.
